TIMES

Turnout starts at 9:00am. Dressage tests will start at 10:00 Noon.
Competition class times will be e-mailed out the day before the show

NUMBERS

- Numbers will be available at the canteen during turnout (In the Viewing lounge)
- Numbers must be worn on rider's backs
- Numbers should be returned at the end of each show

TURNOUT

- You will be expected to prepare a horse and its tack for the show.
- You will be assigned a horse.
- New competitors will be paired up with students who have more experience.
- Turnout is NOT judged!
- No spectators are permitted in the stable or the rings during the turnout or the competition.

PRIZES

Ribbons from 1st to 5th place

Champion and Reserve Champion for each Hunter division and Dressage division.

ENTRIES

- **It is recommended to enter one entire Dressage Division and one entire Hunter Division. This will make you eligible for day end awards!**
- Entries must be received one week prior to the show. Late entries will be accepted however a late fee will apply. Entry fees must accompany the entry forms. No refunds at any time!
- The show secretary has the right to move students into a more appropriate class if the class is not suitable for the rider. The level suitable for each student may vary depending on the entries at each and every show!
- Students are not allowed to cross enter divisions. All classes must be at the same level within the same discipline. ie – you can enter novice dressage classes & pre-novice hunter classes – you would not be permitted to enter both pre-novice & novice hunter classes

ATTIRE

1. It is recommended that you wear a pair of pants over your riding pants, so that you don't get dirty during turnout.
2. For riding you should wear beige or gray riding pants (dark is fine if you don't have a light pair), a riding blouse (or shirt with a raised neck), and a dark show jacket (solid dark sweater or sweatshirt). Riding boots, dark gloves, and certified helmets are mandatory.

REMEMBER

- The horse will not be judged. It is the rider's position and execution of transitions that will be judged. The rider will not be penalized for a horse's actions unless it is the rider who has done something to create the situation.
- It is the rider's responsibility to find someone to call their dressage test if they require it. Please do not ask our show staff or volunteers. They will be busy with other important jobs.
- When competing at a show you should enter in a level lower than what you are schooling. Our shows give students the opportunity to show what they already know.
- If you have a questions / problems ask an instructor (not a student or the judge).
- **HAVE FUN!!!**
- Whether or not you win, remember that you are here because you love riding. Only one person will get the first place ribbon but everyone who tries his or her best is a winner!

VOLUNTEERS

Every show we require 2-3 volunteers to give out ribbons, run dressage tests, open gates.... If you are interested in volunteering at any of our shows please contact your instructor one week prior to the show. Thank you to everyone who has volunteered at our shows in the past.
